

Migrating the UCP Database from One PC to Another

The quickest way to get the print jobs and so forth from an XP computer to a Win7 computer is the following:

Copy these directories (below) off of the XP computer. The ULSMVX and ULSILS directories may be very large, perhaps gigabytes in size.

Also, note that the directories are all hidden, so it's easiest to un-hide them via the Tools/Folder Options/View tab in Windows Explorer. You can get to that quickly by entering ALT-T at an Explorer window.

Also, note that I'm giving the English-language version of the pathnames; in German or Dutch or French Windows, you'd have to figure out the equivalent.

The XP directories are:

C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\ULSMVX C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\ULSILS C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\ULSDAT

C:\Program Files\UlsDb -- This directory contains any custom database stuff.

Now here's the corresponding Win 7 (or higher) directories.

C:\ProgramData\ULSMVX

C:\ProgramData\ULSILS

C:\ProgramData\ULSDAT

C:\Program Files (x86)\UlsDb -- Always look for a "Program Files (x86)" on the Win 7 first, and use the standard "Program Files" only if the computer doesn't have an "(x86)" (it means you're a 32-bit computer).
